"Heartsongs" was his first of six books of poetry and one book of essays, all of which reached the NYT bestsellers list. Mattie suffered from a rare form of muscular dystrophy that resulted in his death a month before hie 14th birthday. His sister and two brothers also died from the disease during early childhood, and his mother has the adult form, diagnosed only after all four of her children were born. In 1999, Mattie was awarded the Melinda Lawrence International Book Award for inspirational written works by Children's Hospice International.
